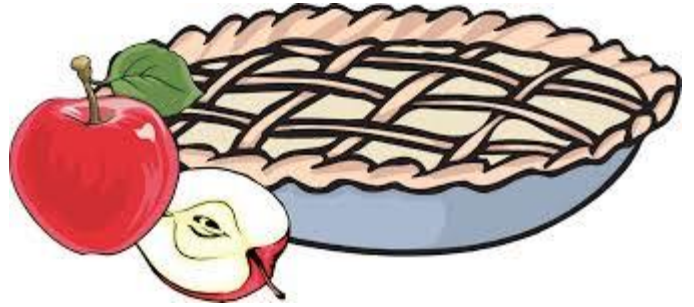


Highline's Annual Gratitude Celebration
